Consistent with federal regulations pertaining to federal financial aid eligibility, the Chief Instructional Officer at each college will ensure compliance with the United States Department of Education's disclosure requirements for each of the college's gainful employment programs by disclosing federally-mandated information about the programs to prospective students. Each college shall make the required disclosures available to prospective students in promotional materials and on its website.

Each college's Chief Instructional Officer shall establish procedures to ensure that the college meets these reporting requirements whenever the college intends to add a new gainful employment program.
